

SOMERSET COUNTY 4-H FAIR SALES POLICY

- Sales of any kind are not permitted at the Fair unless organized or authorized by the 4-H Association.
- Those authorized are the market lamb sale, rabbits, cavies, small animals, poultry and food.
- Food may be sold by 4-H groups or other non-profit organizations designated by the Food Tent Committee.
- The Somerset County 4-H Association shall be paid a commission of ten percent of all 4-H Sales made at the Fair. 4-H Clubs shall contribute all profits to the benefit of their club, other 4-H Program or other charity.
- The Somerset County 4-H Association shall be paid a commission of twenty percent of all non-4-H Food Sales made at the Fair by non-profit organizations.
- At the conclusion of the Fair, gross sales proceeds will be forwarded to the Treasurer of the Somerset County 4-H Association for deposit into the Association Account, unless other arrangements have been made.
- The appropriate percentage of that amount will be remitted in a timely manner to the 4-H group or the non-profit food vendor.
- Food profits and remittance to 4-H Clubs and other nonprofit vendors will be handled by the Treasurer of the Somerset County 4-H Association and the Food Tent Committee.
