

PET THERAPY

OBJECTIVES

Pet Therapy aids people who are elderly, mentally challenged, or who have emotional problems, to open up and share through their response to animals. Club members go to nursing homes, day care centers, schools, and training centers for the handicapped with their animals and visit as a group and on a one-to-one basis. Throughout the year children make gifts and baskets for these residences.

RULES FOR EXHIBITION

3. Exhibits must be received at the 4-H Center by Monday before the Fair.
