

ROCKETRY OBJECTIVE

Club members learn about the principles of rocketry and how to construct a flying model rocket.
RULES AND REQUIREMENTS

6. Only enrolled members of the 4-H Rocketry Club may exhibit.
7. All exhibits must be the work of the member this year.
8. All exhibits must be tagged with the member's name and age
9. All members work towards completing their projects for display and launch at the fair.
10. Rockets must be complete and painted for display in the exhibit.
11. Members must participate in the Fair and at least one of the three launches to be eligible for awards.
12. All rockets will be judged to determine the progress the member has accomplished throughout the year.

CLASSES

1. Junior - new members with less than one year experience in the construction of model rockets.
2. Senior - members experienced with following detailed instructions on how to construct a model rocket. They also will be accumulating knowledge and experience in dealing with construction problems as they arise.
3. Advanced - members with usually three or more years experience. They have the experience to create their own designs under supervision while following established guidelines.
