

## **TWIRLING OBJECTIVES**

To gain confidence by performing twirling routines in front of an audience.  
To learn twirling skills and have fun at the same time.

### **RULES FOR EXHIBITION**

When the members have finalized a group twirling routine to be performed at the Fair or other event, consistent attendance at practices and the performance is strongly recommended. This will insure coordinated teamwork at the performance.

1. Participants must be members in good standing of a 4-H twirling club and have attended at least 70% of the club's meetings, including community service events.
2. Each member must submit a Project Record Sheet.
3. Members are required to wear their 4-H apparel at community events.
4. Each member will contribute to the club Fair display and help set up and take down at the Fair.

### **4-H TWIRLING DEMONSTRATIONS**

1. Twirl with a twirler - Help teach people at the Fair or at other events how to twirl a baton.
2. Group performance.

### **AWARDS**

Each participant will receive a noncompetitive club ribbon.
