

RADIO CONTROL CAR CLUB

Objectives

Members will learn about the building, mechanics/repair and driving of different types of radio control vehicles. Working together to solve problems, they will also learn good sportsmanship

RULES AND REQUIREMENTS FOR EXHIBITION

1. All participants must be active members of the 4-H R/C Car Club and have met the guidelines as stated in the official club rules for Fair participation.
2. All club rules will be in effect for the duration of the Fair. See R/C rulebook for more details.
3. In order to be eligible for racing, a vehicle must participate in the Concourse Event and pass inspection. Remember your vehicle is your 4-H project.
4. Racers must register themselves and their vehicles one hour before each race period. Registration forms must accurately identify vehicles by class and frequency.
5. All radios will be impounded during race periods. No exceptions!
6. Each racer will be provided a Velcro patch for his or her vehicle so that identification numbers can be used during racing. This patch should be placed on the right side of the vehicle. If the number comes off during racing, the vehicle must be pulled off the track, the number replaced or laps will not be counted.
7. Each vehicle must have an appropriate car or truck body according to class.
8. All racers must be ready to race on time and at any time as times can change due to weather conditions.
9. All racers must sign up for marshalling before each session of races. Marshalling is required of all members.
10. Vehicles may be operated only in designated areas and only at designated times.
11. ALL PROJECTS (VEHICLES) MUST BE ON DISPLAY FROM 10am-10pm ALL THREE DAYS OF THE FAIR.
12. All racers must be present for ALL R/C FAIR ACTIVITIES to participate in the races for the day. See rulebook for specifics on Fair Activities.
13. Each racer, along with a parent or responsible adult substitute MUST help with set up and take down of the tent and track.
14. It is mandatory for each family to provide a family member to tent sit during races. A sign up sheet will be available. Failure to sign up or show up will result in the loss of race points for the member.

CLASSES AND AWARDS

Vehicles will be raced in six classes: Buggy Stock, Novice Truck Stock, Truck Stock, Truck Modified, Buggy Modified and Short Course. When all racing has been completed, the following awards will be given: first, second, third place trophies in each class based on the total scores of afternoon and evening racing combined.

In the Concourse Event, vehicles will be judged on the basis of appearance, cleanliness and workmanship. Racers MUST have their original club issued number on their vehicle. Danish ribbons will be awarded. Participants must present their vehicles for judging at 11:00 am on the first race day. To participate in racing, a vehicle must be judged in the Concourse under the name of the person who will be driving the vehicle.

No substitutions of drivers or vehicles will be allowed.
